APPEARANCE:

Opacity: Is it clear, muddy, cloudy?

Viscosity: Does it seem light or thick?

AROMA:

Give your glass a good swirl and

stick your nose inside.

Think about the smells.

Do you smell fruits? Herbs? Woods?

Flowers? All the flavours you'll enjoy

are in the aromas.

PALATE:

Sip your glass of wine and look for the following:

Intensity: Does your mouth feel dry?

Sugary or acidic?

Balance & flavour intensity

Alcohol: Too intense or too little?
